AGREEMENT FORM (Craft Vendors)**

The applicant agrees to comply with all of the following conditions by filling out the application form enclosed and signing below.

1. All items I will display are HANDMADE by me, the exhibiting craft person, and are of first quality. I understand all items not meeting these requirements can and will be removed by the craft fair organizers without any refund of my entry fees. This includes commercially made jewelry, clothes, toys, gadgets, knickknacks, ties, etc.
2. I understand that my enclosed fee is NOT REFUNDABLE unless my application is not accepted or the Fair is canceled.
3. Smoking is not allowed on the premises.
4. The Mosaic Group will not be responsible or liable for the loss of, theft of, or damage to exhibitor's items or for personal injury or the loss of money during the Fair.
5. Each crafter will be required to donate a craft item valued at \$20.00 or more for the free door prize promotion.
6. The facilities must be clean and in good condition upon leaving the premises.
7. Applications with payment must be postmarked no later than 10th of each month.

AGREEMENT FORM (Food Vendors Only)**

The Vendor shall, to the satisfaction of the Festival, fully comply with the Florida Department of Health regulations schedule "B" (please refer to your state regulations documents), assume responsibility and agree as follows:

- a. To furnish all electrical appliances, extension cords and equipment necessary for the preparation of food.
 - b. Furnish anything above and beyond the basic small plates, spoons, forks and napkins, that will be needed to serve at the booth.
 - c. To have the booth completely set-up, decorated and ready to open for sampling by 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the event.
 - d. To clean-up the Vendor's assigned area, including but not limited to the collection of all food, grease, refrigerators, food warmers, paper goods, serving dishes, extra tables and chairs, leaving the assigned area clean within one hour after the event has concluded. In the event that the area is not returned to original condition, the vendor agrees to pay a \$100 clean up fee and pay any additional costs if damage to area is assessed.
 - e. To furnish a booth manager, who shall arrive at the site one hour prior to the start of the event, and who shall remain there until the booth area has been cleaned, named as follows:

- 2 The Vendor shall abide with all applicable Federal, State, County and City laws and regulations and be responsible for obtaining and or possessing any and all permits and licenses that may be required including, State Health Department regulations and food handling permits.
- 3 The Vendor shall procure and maintain, throughout the term of this Agreement, insurance coverage reflecting at a minimum an amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for bodily injury and general liability coverage **(Please contact your insurance provider and request an addendum for _____ to cover this specific event. There will be no additional cost to you)**. The coverage required shall extend to all employees of the Vendor and shall include The Mosaic Group and the City of Delray Beach as additionally insured. ***The certificate of Insurance reflecting the required coverage must be attached, and made a part of this Agreement.***
- 4 For value received, which is hereby acknowledged by the receipt of the booth application fee of \$100.00 non-refundable fee to the Vendor shall defend, indemnify, save, and hold harmless The Mosaic Group and the City of Delray Beach, its assigns, and employees, harmless from any and all claims or causes of action, including without limitation, all damages, losses, liabilities, expenses, costs, and attorney's fees related to such claims, resulting from any negligent or intentional act or omission, or the violation of any federal, state, or local law or regulation, by the vendor, its subcontractors, agents, assigns, invitees, or employees in connection with this Agreement. The Vendor further acknowledges that he or she is solely responsible for ensuring its compliance and the compliance of its subcontractors, agents, assigns, invitees and employees with the terms of this Agreement. The provisions of this paragraph survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

- 5 The Vendor shall not assign, delegate, or otherwise transfer its rights and obligations as set forth in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the “Event” Chair. Any attempted assignment in violation of this provision shall be void.
- 6 The laws of the State of Florida shall govern all aspects of this Agreement. In the event it is necessary for either party to initiate legal action regarding this Agreement, venue shall be in the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit for claims under state law and in the Southern District of Florida for any claims which are justifiable in federal court.
- 7 The Event may terminate this Agreement at any time upon twenty-four (24) hours prior notice to the Vendor or the day of the event if vendor is not complying with agreement or a natural disaster/ weather occurs.
- 8 Except those provisions contained within which survive the termination of this agreement, the terms of this Agreement shall commence on the acceptance date by the Vendor on the last page of this Agreement and shall continue until all contractual obligations are completed.
- 9 There will be a **mandatory phone call orientation within 1 week prior to event**. Any changes to the final layout must be made at this time. Your business will be contacted with details of this meeting. ***No changes will be made on the day of the event.***
